The Trustees reserve the right to waive any and all technicalities and/or irregularities, to reject any and all bids, to reject bids that they find to be unbalanced and to defer acceptance of any bid for a period not to exceed thirty-five (35) calendar days from the date of letting. Bids will be received to complete all parts of the proposed project, which if accepted, will be covered under one contract.  
Each bid shall be in writing on a form furnished by the Drainage District; must be filed with the City Clerk of Eagle Grove, Iowa in a sealed envelope plainly identified and addressed to the City Clerk, Eagle Grove, Iowa and must be accompanied by a bid security in a separate sealed envelope. The bid security must be either (1) bid bond (2) a certified or cashier's check drawn on a bank in Iowa (3) cash or (4) a certified share draft from a credit union in Iowa. The bid security shall be made payable to the City Clerk of Eagle Grove, Iowa for Drainage District No. 15 at his/her office; in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total. The bid security must not contain any conditions either in the body or as an endorsement thereon. The bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them in accordance with paragraph 8.02 of the Instructions to Bidders. The bid security of the successful bidder will be held as a guarantee and not returned until after he has entered into a contract in accordance with his bid. Such bid security shall be forfeited to the Drainage District as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails or refuses to enter into a contract within fifteen (15) days after receipt of Notice of Award of the contract.  
The successful bidder shall be required to execute bonds, with sureties approved by the City Clerk, in favor of The City of Eagle Grove for the use and benefit of Drainage District No. 15, and all persons entitled to liens for labor or material in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price of the work to be done; conditioned for the timely, efficient, and complete performance of the contract; and the payment, as they become due, of all just claims for labor performed and material used in carrying out the contract. All conditions of these bonds shall conform with the forms of Bonds included in the Contract Forms and shall remain in effect until one (1) year after the date of final acceptance of the work by the Eagle Grove City Council as Trustees for the District.  
Payment for work done will be in accordance with estimates approved monthly by the Engineer and by check issued by the City of Eagle Grove for the District and approved by the Council as Trustees for the District.  
Progress payments will be made in an amount equal to ninety percent (90%) of the work completed. Final payment will be made not less than thirty (30) days after completion of the work and acceptance by the City Council, subject to the conditions and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 468 of the Code of Iowa, as amended.  
No such final payment will be due until the Contractor certifies to the Trustees that the materials, labor, and services involved in the final estimate have been paid for in accordance with the requirements stated in the specifications. The City of Eagle Grove, Iowa is exempt from paying Sales and Use Tax and will supply Contractor with an "Iowa Sales Tax Exemption Certificate" and an authorization letter to allow the Contractor to buy equipment and material for the project tax free.  
The work shall commence on or before November 1, 2019. All work of Divisions

I and II shall be completed on or before September 4, 2020. All work of Division III shall be completed on or before May 15, 2020. Liquidated damages in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per calendar day will be assessed to the Contractor for each day that the work of Division III shall remain uncompleted after May 15, 2020 with due allowance for extensions of the contract period due to conditions beyond the control of the Contractor. Liquidated damages for Division I and Division II work in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per calendar day will be assessed to the Contractor for each day that the work shall remain uncompleted after the end of the contract period with due allowance for extensions of the contract period due to conditions beyond the control of the Contractor.  
By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa.  
In accordance with Iowa statutes, a resident bidder shall be allowed a preference as against a nonresident bidder from a state or foreign country if that state or foreign country gives or requires any preference to bidders from that state or foreign country, including but not limited to any preference to bidders, the imposition of any type of labor force preference, or any other form of preferential treatment to bidders or laborers from that state or foreign country. The preference allowed shall be equal to the preference given or required by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident. In the instance of a resident labor force preference, a nonresident bidder shall apply the same resident labor force preference to a public improvement in this state as would be required in the construction of a public improvement by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident.  
Failure to submit a fully completed Bidder Status Form with the bid may result in the bid being deemed nonresponsive and rejected.

Approved claims for payment.  
Wayne Judkins with Community and Family Resources presented a Proclamation declaring September as National Recovery Month. Section 1. Wright County Board of Supervisors does hereby request that an election be held for the purpose of renewing the local option sales tax and placing the question on a Special Election ballot on March 3, 2020.
