Approved claims for payment. Sandy McGrath with Wright County Public Health gave an update on the COVID cases in Wright County. There are a total of 2.170 positive cases since March 2020. A total of 59.5% of Wright County residents have been fully vaccinated. Mc-Grath states if an individual is fully vaccinated they should wait 3 to 5 days to get tested if exposed and 5 to 7 days to get tested if not vacci-

nated and exposed. Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, gave an update on the Secondary Roads. The rock and gravel spot loads are starting this week in preparation for harvest. Crews will start mowing gravel roads the first week in October. There were 4 work orders completed last week with one being the box culvert for Bridge 102. The total cost for Bridge 102 was around \$130,000. Bridge 105 has been delayed due to materials being delayed. Crews started on concrete patching today. C20 paving is tentatively starting on Wednesday, September 15th.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to appoint Darrel Steven Carlyle to MIDAS as a voting board member and also to the Mid Iowa Growth Partnership Board of Directors. Motion carries.
