Sandy McGrath gave an update on the COVID cases in Wright County. There is currently 1,759 cases since March 2020. There have been 5,411 doses that have been administered. Out of those 1,151 were 1st doses, 1,476 were 2nd doses and 1,324 were the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. Wright County Public Health is still receiving 200 doses per week. Wright County is still requiring masks in public indoor spaces as well as continuing social distancing. They are still encouraging people to get tested and quarantining if testing positive.

Corrective conveyance of Lot #6 in the Agribusiness Park was tabled. Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, gave an update on Secondary Roads. The crews are going to start working on spot loading for the rock/gravel program this week. There were 13 work orders completed last week, 12 of which were brush cutting and 1 was cold patching on C20 where 150 feet of asphalt was removed and filled with limestone. Clemons stated that they have found a new product for cold patching that should last 5 years compared to the one that is used now that last about a year. All trucks went out at 6 a.m. on March 15th on hard surfaces only for the snow

Clemons gave update on the Highway 69 bridge project. The project is to begin later this month with a completion date of November 2021. There will be a detour for this project on C20

Wright County Board of Health has extended mask mandate for 30 days. They are looking to lift mandates at next meeting after more individuals have been vaccinated and positive cases are down
